What we do

- **WCAG 2.2 AA audits** — automated scanning plus expert manual and assistive-technology review.
- **Code-level remediation guidance** — every issue with the WCAG criterion, the current code, and the fix.
- **Developer support & verification** — consult hours, code/PR review; you fix, we confirm with before/after evidence.
- **VPAT / ACR** — Accessibility Conformance Reports for procurement and Section 508.
- **Documents, media & monitoring** — PDF accessibility, captions/transcripts, and ongoing checks so accessibility doesn’t drift.
