Beneficiary Designation Information Sheet

For your financial institution, retirement plan, or insurance company

Naming ACBVI as a beneficiary on a retirement account, life insurance policy, bank account, or other financial account is one of the simplest planned gifts available. It requires no attorney, no changes to your will, and no IRS filing.

Contact your financial institution and request a beneficiary designation change form. Provide the information below. You can designate ACBVI as a primary beneficiary, a contingent (secondary) beneficiary, or for a specific percentage of the account.

Steps

1. Contact your financial institution, retirement plan administrator, or insurance company.
2. Request a beneficiary designation form (sometimes called a Transfer on Death or TOD form).
3. Complete the form using the legal name and EIN above. Specify whether ACBVI is a primary or contingent beneficiary, and what percentage of the account you wish to designate.
4. Return the completed form to your institution. Keep a copy for your records.
5. You can update or change your beneficiary designation at any time during your lifetime — no irrevocable commitment is required.
